Statement

at the Papal Audience on the occasion of the XIII International Pilgrimage of Altar Servers on St. Peter's Square on 30 July 2024

Dear Altar Servers,

I would like to personally welcome you all to this place. I'm glad to see you here!

The logo of our XIII international pilgrimage to Rome shows the keys of St. Peter. These keys represent the authority and the responsibility which Jesus gave to Peter, and through him to the whole Church. But these are more than just historical symbols. For me and hopefully for many other people too, they are a sign of hope and of the future. This is a future which you are; for the world and for the Church.

If you wish to do so, you altar servers carry these keys of St. Peter in you.

Through your lives, your commitment, your faith and your service, you help to make the world a better place day by day. You are the bridge builders creating a link between the generations, and thus making the living presence of God visible in the world.

Keys can open doors, you know that. Just imagine, to put it symbolically, that you are a key and can open up new things and good things, healing things, if you are willing to take responsibility and play an active role in shaping the future of the Church.
